

LIVESTOCK AGENTS AS INFORMATION PROVIDERS

Assigning an Information Provider to record NAIT movements on your behalf



An information provider is an accredited company or individual that can complete NAIT tasks on your behalf. If your local livestock agent works for an accredited company or is an accredited individual, they can record farm-to-farm movements for you.

You must assign the information provider in your NAIT account to give them permission to record your movements, even if you have entered into an agreement with them.

Do this as soon as possible to ensure the movement can be recorded within 48 hours.





ASSIGN INFORMATION PROVIDERS TO YOUR NAIT NUMBER:

- Log into your NAIT account and click 'Manage NAIT Activities' then 'View/Update NAIT Number Registration Details'.
- In the 'Information Providers' panel, click 'Add new'.
- Select the organisation you want to add. Click 'Continue'.

If your local livestock agent works for an accredited company, you need to select the company name from the information provider list.

It is your responsibility as the person in charge of animals (PICA) to ensure movements are recorded within the 48-hour time frame. When using an Information Provider, look out for email notifications, log in to NAIT, or call us.
